
- · Colonel Robert Eden Handy Rifle
- · Inscribed "Robert Eden Handy, San Jacinto, April 21, 1836"
- Our most amazing acquisition since the Alamo Doors! This beautiful .50
 caliber plains saddle rifle has a 31" octagon barrel and beautiful Maple stock.
- Handy was sent (along with Henry Karnes and Deaf Smith) by General Sam Houston to investigate the conditions at the Alamo when he encountered Susannah Dickinson, who relayed the information that the Alamo had fallen!
- The rifle was presented to Handy for his bravery at the battle of San Jacinto.



"Give your Mother the "Boot" on Mother's Day" and other "sage" advice from our early years

We've been at this for nearly 50 years—and one of our favorite things is looking back at how it all began. Here's a gem: our very first Mother's Day Newsletter from 1980, where we introduced the beloved boot mugs and encouraged you to "give your mother the boot!"

That first newsletter went out to just 45 customers on March 26, 1980. If you still have one from the year 1980, bring it in for a complimentary boot mug! Edd wrote those early editions around 1:30 a.m. after long shifts—so yes, a few typos made it in. Highlights included the purchase of a desktop computer for our general ledger, a piña colada recipe (sadly retired), and a \$2 coupon begging folks to come back.



The early years of our business were admittedly lean. We were desperate for business, which led to some – we think- very clever marketing schemes. Do you remember Andy Angus? We offered Certified Angus Beef tastings in Neiman Marcus and Continental Finer Foods in the old Town and Country Village. Andy Angus (usually Edd or Edd K in an Angus Bull mascot costume) offered tastes of our grilled CAB steaks to passersby. Other efforts included the Ambassador Pass (a buy-one get-one entrée), Movies and Rockets Games in the Lone Star Saloon (peanut shells on the ground included!) and a Ribeye Eating Contest for the University of Houston Defensive Line vs. Offensive Line. These are all priceless memories to us!
