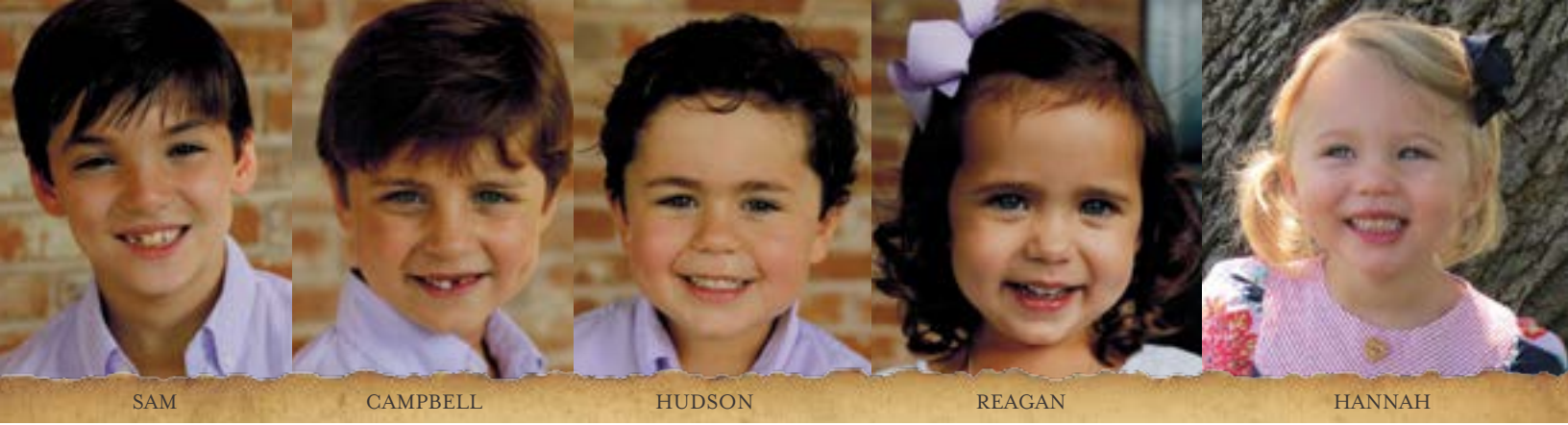

SAN FELIPE de AUSTIN
State Historic Site

Just west of Houston, one of the most notable sites in Texas, San Felipe, bids visitors to remember shadows of its earliest days. There is a rich history here that marks the days of early Texas settlers and our most recognized heroes of the Republic of Texas. It was at San Felipe that Stephen F. Austin succeeded his father, Moses Austin, as empresario to the Mexican government. He brought colonists to settle the territory from present-day Navasota and La Grange to the Gulf of Mexico, and Austin established San Felipe de Austin as the colony’s capital in 1823. It was a most diverse community of cultures. Later it was here the early people of Texas carved out their journey of independence from Mexico. Residents of the colony included Gail Borden, Jr., founder of the Borden Milk Company, and William Barrett Travis. Santa Ana and Texas hero, Sam Houston, are among those who commanded their armies through this memorable landmark. The Friends of San Felipe de Austin are now working on building a visitor’s center and museum to preserve this most important historical and archaeological site of our state.
