Looking Back at 1977

On November 19, 1977, Taste of Texas opened its doors on the back side of Town and Country Village in a location that had been 4 restaurants previously. Our original place included the "Lone Star Saloon", Chicken Fried Steak, and a much more casual dining theme. Over the years we found our place as a great Steakhouse and the rest is history.

- The price of oil was \$14.40 per barrel (\$57.20 in 2017 dollars).
- A gallon of gas was about 65 cents.
- The Trans-Alaskan oil pipeline open on May 31, 1977.
- Houston had a population of between 1.2 and 1.5 million
- Kenny Rogers, Loretta Lynn, and Waylon Jennings topped the Country music charts.
- Elvis Presley released his last album, "Welcome to My World." He passed away in August 1977.
- The first Apple II computers went on sale for \$1300 with 4KB or RAM
